Step 1 Facilitator Welcome: Welcome to Lesson 8 our final Calling All Colors learning session. Today we are going to reflect on the impact of our Action Plan and prepare for our Calling All Colors Spring Conference Presentation.

Step 2: The Impact of Our Action Plan (5 minutes) !

Facilitator: Let's reflect on the impacts of our action plan. Using a marker and piece of paper please write down in bold lettering one word that summarizes how you feel about either our work as a Calling All Colors Group or the influence our Action Plan has had on the school. Next, we are going to hear from a few volunteers. Please share your word and a brief explanation on why you chose it. Please have a note taker jot down some of the major highlights on a white board.

Step 3: Our Action Plan CAC Spring Conference Presentation

Facilitator: Now finally let's prepare for our Action Plan Presentation. We have already summarized some of the major highlights of how our Action Plan impacted our school. These are listed on our white board.

- Are there any other aspects of our action plan can we integrate into our presentation?
- Do we have pictures, quotes from students, or staff, action plan swag (t-shirts, pins, banners), or interviews from students, staff etc?
- What's the best way to present our action plan in a manner which will help the conference participants fully understand what we accomplished; power point, video, viral videos, vlogs etc?
- Remember our presentation must stay within an approximately 5 minute time frame.
